

-MA103 HIKING TO ESMERALDA LAGOON-

CONNECTING WITH DEEP NATURE

This is not just a simple hike; it's an immersive experience for nature lovers who want to truly understand the unique ecosystems of Tierra del Fuego.

We start with a transfer from your hotel to the trailhead, but not before stopping to enjoy a ****breathtaking panoramic view of Ushuaia and the Beagle Channel****. There's nothing like a bird's-eye perspective to spark the sense of adventure!



Our journey takes us through a trail surrounded by Ñire and Lenga forests, ancient trees that tell their story through their twisted, resilient forms. Here, every detail of the flora has its purpose: from the humble yellow violet, adding color to the landscape, to the rare dog and yellow orchids, whose existence depends on symbiosis with local insects and fungi.

Did you know that these forests are the lungs that keep the surrounding peat bogs and wetlands alive? These mossy, watery landscapes are remnants of ancient glaciers that shaped our territory, and here is where we begin to understand how the water dynamics sculpt these valleys.



But nature doesn't stop there. As we walk, we'll also meet the beaver, an invader who, although not native, has drastically altered the landscape.

OUR EXPERT NATURALIST GUIDE WILL NOT ONLY EXPLAIN ITS IMPACT BUT ALSO HELP YOU UNDERSTAND HOW THIS RODENT INTERACTS WITH LOCAL ECOSYSTEMS, AFFECTING THE FLORA, WATER SYSTEMS, AND EVEN THE FAUNA. IT'S A REAL LESSON IN ECOLOGY IN ACTION!

When we reach Laguna Esmeralda, it's not just about taking in its beauty.



We'll pause to study the microcosm that thrives around the lagoon: small insects, aquatic plants, and even migratory birds that find refuge in this hidden corner. Here, we don't just admire the landscape; we understand it deeply.

On the way back, the valley reveals even more secrets, as our guide invites you to discover how every plant and every animal plays a crucial role in maintaining the balance of life in these southern lands.
